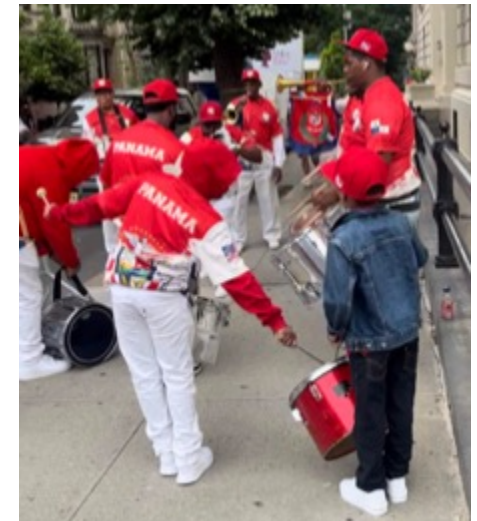

New York City has the largest concentration of Haitians in the United States as well as the oldest established Haitian communities of the country.

According to the 2022 census, there were 176,287 Haitians living in New York, with the largest population residing in Brooklyn, however, those figures are well understated.

Queens boasts the second largest Haitian population in New York City, while Manhattan, the Bronx and Long Island have smaller, yet influential pockets pockets of the population.

Haitians have also established a stronghold in Rockland and Westchester Counties, just north of New York City and have significant representation in New Jersey(Elizabeth, Union, Irvington) and Connecticut (Bridgeport).
